What is covered in a TACS demonstration?

Taking trucks into schools, TACS demonstrators teach children about the dangers of trucks, and road safety. The demonstrations are delivered free of charge by DHL employees who are fully DBS checked and include:



- What exactly the driver can or cannot see in the mirrors
- Children become aware of the truck's dimensions
- Just how loud is the engine?
- Sound
- What and where, are the vehicle's blind spots?
- How difficult it is it for a driver, whilst inside the cab to hear a child shouting?
- What distance is needed on the nearside when a vehicle is turning left at a junction?



- Children learn how to walk safely around the vehicle and where to stand on the pavement
- What should you do if a football runs under a truck?

TACS is the only road safety programme to use an actual 44 tonne truck and trailer as a visual aid. The overall message of TACS supports PSHE within the National Curriculum. At DHL we are passionate about safety and hope you can help us achieve our aim of keeping children safe around trucks.
